



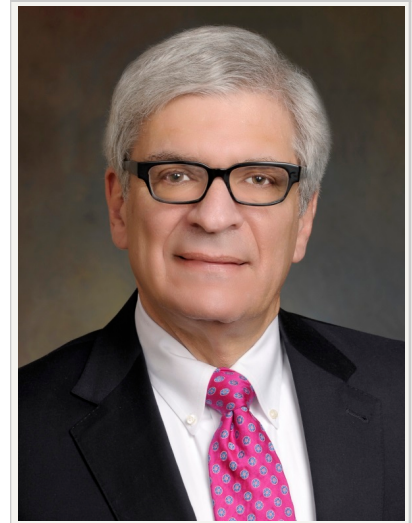


**IRA J. KALTMAN**
